Church Street Remembrance Sunday

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Borough Council of Newcastle-under-Lyme in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and all other enabling powers on April 21st 2026 made an Order, the effect of which is that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, drive or ride any motor vehicle, horse, cart, carriage, bicycle or other vehicle of any description in or along the roads specified in the Schedule, or cause or permit any vehicle to enter the road or length of roads as specified in the Schedule hereto.

Any person who wilfully breaches the Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding Level 3 on the standard scale.

SCHEDULE

The closure will take place from 9.30am to 12.30pm on Sunday 8th November 2026.

Location: Maddock Street - Entire Length, George Street - Entire Length, Wereton Road from its junction with Queen's Street to its junction with Church Street, Maddock Street - Entire Length, Queen Street - Entire Length, Meadowside Avenue - Entire Length, Chester Road - Entire Length, Church Street - Entire Length, Wereton Road from its Junction with Queen Street to its junction with Chester Road, Vernon Avenue from its Junction with Meadowside Avenue to its junction with Wereton Road, Nantwich Road from its Junction with Chester Road to its junction with Church Street.
